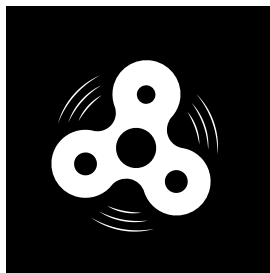
## Where will I go?

# What to Bring?



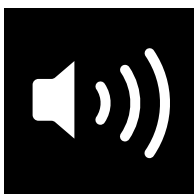
I can bring these items to help me feel comfortable and relaxed.

- Hand sanitiser

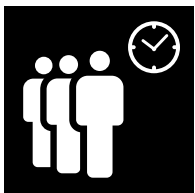
They will help me prepare for spaces that might have loud sounds or be very noisy.



## Getting here

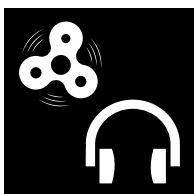

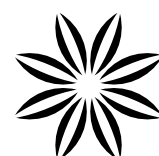


A Sydney Science Trail helper will greet me and help me if I need it.

There will be signs to help me find where to go.

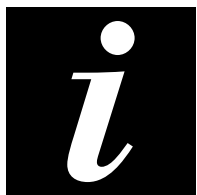

At the Royal Botanic Garden Sydney I will stay close to my group and my teacher or carer.

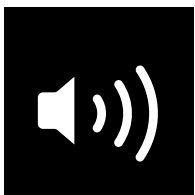


Sydney Science Trail helpers wear a green shirt. They can help me if I have a question.

## Sydney Science Trail Science Show



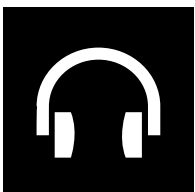
At the Royal Botanic Garden Sydney I will do two activities.

I can use the toilets at Rathborne Lodge – near the grey wall.





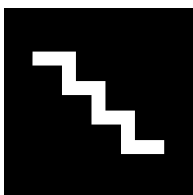
## Where can I go if I need somewhere quiet?

## Exiting the Royal Botanic Garden Sydney

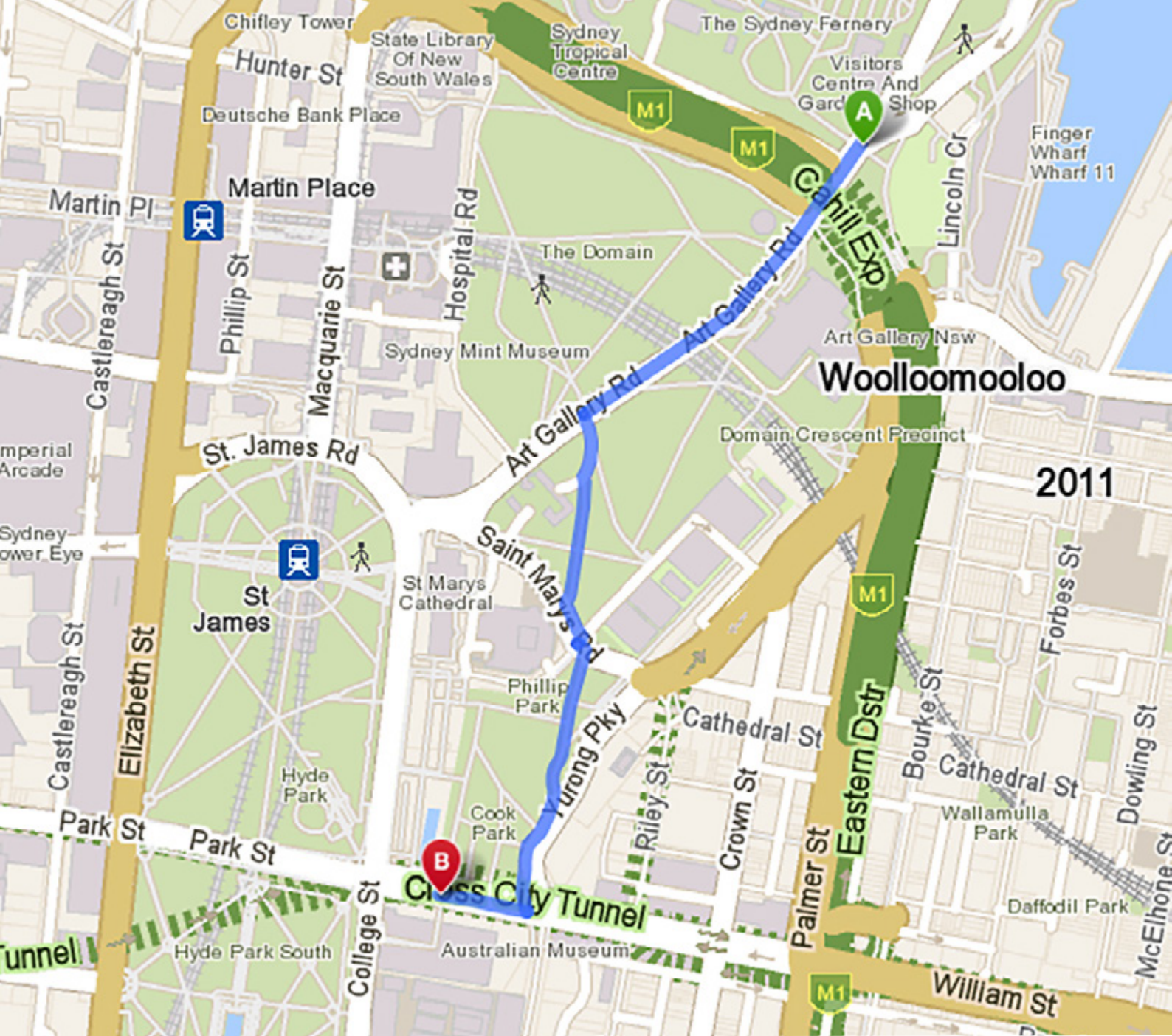


When it is time to exit the Gardens, I will follow my teacher or carer.



If I have not visited the Australian Museum, I will walk there next.



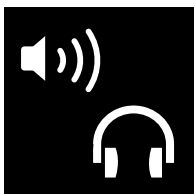


## Walking to the Australian Museum
